The percentage of women having good dietary diversity knowledge during pregnancy was 69.1 %. Most believe that food diversity is needed for the proper development of fetus during pregnancy. The prevalence of good dietary diversity practice during pregnancy was 48.4%. 90% of the women reported that they consumed cereal-based crops.


