Q 1 Please summarize the main findings of the study.

Authors presented associations of longer weekly work hours which increased nurse turnover. and nonlinear relationship which was observed between overtime and turnover in the total model. They also presented that earning from the primary nursing position decreased nurse turnover, except for those working in settings other than hospitals. Finding also showed that job satisfaction decreased turnover.

Q 2 Please highlight the limitations and strengths.

Major concern of this manuscript is the retrospective approach and using data with 5 years delay. It is not sure if authors participated in collection data or just used data from the national association which organized survey.

2. In abstract please add statistical results and statistical significance to your main findings.
3. In introduction you starting with COVID 19 as a significant reason for nursing turnover but at that time the data is collected there was no pandemic. Please better describe which new knowledge you are aiming to bring with your research. If you want to raise attention of international audience you have to give
4. Methodology is presented well. Statistical methods were applied correctly.
5. Results – tables are clear.
6. Discussion – please assure better connection of your results and international findings, please refer to the Tables from the result section.
7. Limitations – major limitation is old data
8. Conclusion – please can you be more specific in recommendations for nurses managers. It is important to show practical benefit of your findings.
