### **EVALUATION**

### Q 1 Please summarize the main findings of the study.

This cross-sectional survey conducted in Poland aimed to assess public awareness of genitourinary cancers (kidney, bladder, and prostate) risk factors and identify associated factors. Factors associated with higher awareness included female gender, higher education, occupational activity, and the presence of chronic diseases. The study revealed significant gaps in public awareness of genitourinary cancers risk factors in Poland, suggesting a need for targeted education and awareness campaigns to address these gaps.

## Q 2 Please highlight the limitations and strengths.

Among the strengths of this study are the updated statistics from 2024, recruiting a huge nationally representative sample size for survey, and assessing a wide range of factors associated with awareness of genitourinary cancers risk factors. However, the limitations of this study were the cross-sectional design limiting some casual inferences, the nature of self-reported findings, and limited practical public health implications of the findings regarding prevention of genitourinary cancers.

- 5. Methods: please expand the part about developing the survey questionnaire. Did authors conduct any validations on the developed tool?


